Andreas Neubacher is working in the Telecommunication sector since 1999. He was responsible for the development of national deployment plans for the 3G radio access network in Austria. In 2003, he joined the Deutsche Telekom Standardization and IPR management group, where he headed various projects such as network sharing, Self-Organizing Networks, home NodeBs, VoLTE Roaming in Standards. Andreas represents Deutsche Telekom in various global organizations like 3GPP, ETSI, IEEE, oneM2M, and has set up and chaired Open Radio Interface study group (ORI ISG) in ETSI. Currently, Andreas is heading standardization activities in the IoT area for Deutsche Telekom group (DTAG).
